MAKE AN OATH TO DO MORE

When all people of CONSCIENCE do more than we are currently doing to create peace and nonviolence, our collective actions will greatly transform the world in which we live.

Choose from the following actions or come up with your own.

1. Call, write or visit your congressional representative each week and demand that he or she stop funding and supporting the wars in Iraq and Afganistan.
(www.house.gov/writerep/)
2. Vote and make funding and supporting war and other acts of violence a disqualifying criteria for earning your precious vote.
3. Regularly attend demonstrations for peace in your community. Organize one outside the office your congressional representative.
4. Donate money directly to support nonviolence training, education, and action. (Consider a donation to Be Love or see the various organizations listed on the Knowledge Page of this site).
5. Give a '64 Ways Nonviolence Curriculum Guide' to a teacher or take one to your local school principal or district. (Contact be-love@earthlink.net for support. See Curriculum Page on this site to view excerpts from this extremely valuable resource).
6. Attend a civil disobedience training to prepare for nonviolent direct action. (e-mail be-love@earthlink.net for further information).

7. Refuse to pay all or a portion of your federal income taxes for war and direct the money instead to a cause you do support. (Link to further information at www.wartaxboycott.org and www.nwtrcc.org).
8. Call your congressional representative each week and demand that he or she support impeachment proceedings for both President Bush and Vice President Cheney for the multitude of crimes they have committed against humanity. (www.house.gov/writerep/)
9. Take time daily to envision Peace and Love for all beings.
10. Write a letter to the editor of your local newspaper once per month expressing your feelings on issues pertaining to peace and social justice in your community.
11. Pledge to keep your television off 50 to 100% of the time you currently spend watching.
12. Invest any money that you invest into businesses that give full respect to the environment and human rights. (Invest zero money in any corporation that profits from violence of any kind; physical, emotional, or economic).
13. Plant a tree, grow food, eat foods that suffer no violence.
